



Our Policy

Watershed High School has an open enrollment policy. Thus, all students applying have an equal opportunity for open slots in the classrooms. After the open enrollment window for the following school year is closed and current students have indicated their intent to return, the available slots will be filled first with siblings of current students. At that point, if the number of students who would like to come to Watershed High School exceeds the remaining space available, we will hold a lottery. Parents of students chosen for the open slots will be notified within a short time and asked to fill out an enrollment packet confirming their intent to send their child(ren) to Watershed High School.

Students not chosen will be placed on a waiting list. If a student enrolls, their siblings will also be enrolled, providing space is available. If anyone declines the opportunity to enroll, the next child on the waiting list will be offered a spot. Applications received after the lottery will be placed on the wait list in the order they are received and offered spots after all the lottery students have accepted or declined enrollment.
